Procedure for Speaking Before the Council

- Speakers must complete the information form and submit to the transcriber prior to the public forum. Be prepared to speak when your name is called.
- Each speaker will be allowed three (3) minutes.
- When appropriate, and large groups are speaking on the same topic, one person for the group should be nominated to speak on the topic.
- Speakers may comment on issues scheduled for consideration at the meeting or other appropriate concerns pertinent to the operation of the town.
- Each speaker should state the following:
 - o His/her name
 - o Whether they are a Pleasant View resident and/or property owner
- No person shall be allowed to make obscene, derogatory, or slanderous remarks
 while addressing the Board. Persons doing so will be asked to stop speaking
 and will forfeit the remainder of their time.

- All remarks shall be directed to the Board as a body only.
- No person shall be allowed to disrupt or interfere with the procedures.
- Remarks shall end when the speaker's allotted time has expired. No time shall be shared with other speakers.
- Questions from the Board members may be asked for clarification; however, no person shall be permitted to enter into any discussion or debate either directly with or through any member of the Board or anyone present at the meeting.
